



Procedure on the day of vaccination

① Submission

of vaccination tickets, etc.

Please submit these 3 items; the vaccination ticket, the pre-examination slip (filled in in advance), and the identity verification documents (health insurance card, etc.).

② Confirmation

of pre-examination slip

A public health nurse will check the contents of the pre-examination slip.

③ Preliminary examination

by a doctor

The doctor will see you to determine if you can get your vaccination.

④ Inoculation

Inoculation will take place. Following the procedure, please receive the vaccination certificate with the vaccine sticker.

⑤ Follow-up

Your condition will be monitored for 15 to 30 minutes. Please wait at the designated place.



Precautions

- Vaccination is by appointment only. Please be sure to make a reservation on the applicable date.
- Please check the date and time of your reservation and come to the venue. It will take about 1 hour.
- The vaccine will be injected into your upper arm, so please arrive wearing clothes that allow you to easily expose your shoulder.
- Please wear a mask to prevent possible infection of COVID-19.
- Please fill in the pre-examination slip with a ballpoint pen (pencils and erasable pens are not allowed).
- If you have a fever or other flu-like symptoms, please do not go to the venue and contact the Health and Longevity Division.
